2. Safe & Sober Living Environment

- No drugs, alcohol, or weapons are allowed on the premises at any time.
- All residents must maintain a clean and sober lifestyle.
- Upon entry, residents must pass an initial drug test.
- Random drug testing will be conducted weekly.

We are all battling addiction, which can be cunning and baffling. These rules are in place to protect everyone's recovery and safety.

3. Brotherhood & Respect

- Every resident is expected to treat others with respect and dignity.
- No fighting, threats, or verbal abuse will be tolerated.
- We hold each other accountable as brothers.

This is a place of unity, not division. We rise together.

4. Accountability & Structure

- Residents are required to attend 2 AA meetings a week.
- Church attendance on Sundays is mandatory.
- Active participation in recovery is expected from all residents.

Recovery requires action, consistency, and willingness.

5. House Responsibilities

- Residents must keep their rooms and shared spaces clean.
- Chores will be assigned and must be completed regularly.

- Respect the home and the property at all times.

A clean environment supports a clear mind.

6. Curfew & Conduct

- Residence curfew during the week 10 PM and weekends 11 PM.
- Overnight absences must be approved in advance.
- Guests are only permitted in the common areas.

Structure helps build discipline and stability.

7. Violations & Consequences

- Any violation of these guidelines may result in disciplinary action.
- Serious violations (such as drug use, possession of weapons, or violence) may result in immediate termination from the program.

These rules are not meant to punish, but to protect the brotherhood and everyone's recovery journey.
